

Update: June 29, 2020

General Guidelines:

- 1. <u>Wear a face mask</u>: if you are not in your apartment, we ask that you wear a face mask. That includes common areas, hallways, laundry rooms, etc.
- 2. <u>Hand sanitize</u> any time you enter the building or enter a common area. This will prevent outside germs from spreading into our community.
- 3. <u>Social distance:</u> Please maintain a 6ft distance between you and others while in the building.
- 4. <u>Postpone Visitors</u>: Please ask visitors to be vigilant with their own health. Ask that they postpone visiting if they are sick or showing any symptoms of fever, cough, loss of taste/smell, shortness of breath.
- 5. <u>Deliveries</u>: Deliveries can now be brought into the building, but delivery person is required to wear a mask.

Social Distancing Policies:

• MASKS:

- <u>RESIDENTS</u>: Strongly encouraged when using common spaces and when in groups while outside. Not required when outside and practicing social distancing. Example: Outside when gardening alone it is understandable if you choose not to wear a mask.
- <u>VISITORS</u>: Mandatory when inside building, strongly encouraged when outside in groups

VISITORS

- o Still strongly encouraging limitation of non-essential visitation, but understand that meeting with family is important for mental health and well-being
- Encourage outside visitation rather than inside if possible.
- Visiting residents in common areas or apartments is permitted if outside meetings are not possible and if social distancing is practice. Communities will make a couple areas available for visiting family inside. Add cleaning supplies and make sure these areas are regularly cleaned.

Additional Guidance for Senior Living Communities:

• Gathering:

- At this time we would like to begin allowing groups of 4 or less to congregate in the common areas. Please adhere to all guidelines above, including wearing masks and social distancing.
- o Community events are still on hold, as well as puzzles in the common areas.

• Meals:

 We will continue to offer meals TO-GO, but unfortunately are not ready to have meals held in the dining rooms yet.

• Hair Salon:

• We are allowing the hair salons to open to residents only right now. We hope to open that up to outside clients in the near future.
