



COMMUNITY UPDATE: JUNE 16, 2020

Dear Community Member,

We know you are anxious to begin gathering and find some normalcy to life again. We want nothing more than to do that, but are also being very cautious in an effort to avoid any outbreaks. Here is our plan for re-opening at this time:

1) General Guidelines:

- a. Wear a face mask: if you are not in your apartment, we ask that you wear a face mask. That includes common areas, hallways, laundry rooms, etc.
- b. Hand sanitize any time you enter the building or enter a common area. This will prevent outside germs from spreading into our community.
- c. Social distance: Please maintain a 6ft distance between you and others while in the building.
- d. Postpone Visitors: Please ask visitors to be vigilant with their own health. Ask that they postpone visiting if they are sick or showing any symptoms of fever, cough, loss of taste/smell, shortness of breath.

2) Gathering:

- a. At this time we would like to begin allowing groups of 4 or less to congregate in the common areas. Please adhere to all General Guidelines above, including wearing masks and social distancing.
- b. Community events are still on hold, as well as puzzles in the common areas.

3) Meals:

- a. We will continue to offer meals TO-GO, but unfortunately are not ready to have meals held in the dining rooms yet.

4) Hair Salon:

- a. We are allowing the hair salons to open to residents only right now. We hope to open that up to outside clients in the near future.

We hope this finds letter finds you well during this time and we appreciate your patience as we look to the State for guidance on how to navigate this unprecedented time.
